On January 14, 1984, we packed our two children, Jason 5 and Asha 3 and moved from Denver, Colorado to Tempe, Arizona to start our ministry at Arizona State University, Tempe campus. Now over 15,000 international students from over 150 nations attend Arizona State University. More than 85% of these internationals are from 10/40 windows, the most restricted part of the world as far as the Gospel is concerned. Sociologists tell us that the ages 18-27 is the most critical time in a person's life, when convictions are developed. College students are a generation, and we must reach them with the Gospel of Christ since they are going to be the leaders of the world. We thank God for bringing the world to our doorstep. There may be no better opportunity for world evangelization than that of reaching these international students for Christ. Not only do they represent a potent missionary force as they return to their homeland, but the opportunity for open interaction is often greater on a university campus than in their homeland.

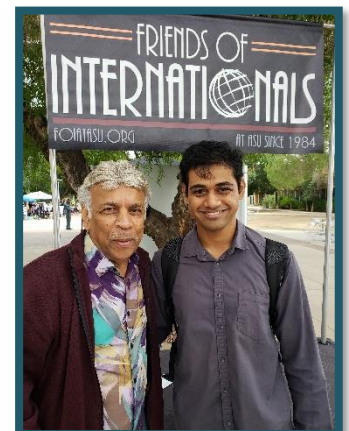
